



Financial Aid Application 2011-2012 School Year

The Financial Aid program is available to assist families with the cost of tuition in the form of need-based grants. The amount awarded is influenced by the number of applicants and the amount of money that the school has allocated for aid.

All applicants who receive awards will be required to substantiate all applicant data by submitting a copy of tax returns for the applicable year. (i.e. Financial Aid application is made in February 2011 for School Year 2011-2012.) The School will request a copy of the 2010 tax returns upon completion on or around April 15, 2011. Failure to comply with the request may result in the retraction of any awarded funds.

The following information is required **in addition to** the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) form which is available through School and Student Services (SSS), an agency sponsored by the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS). SSS forms are available by request from the Business Manager and can also be completed online at www.nais.org/financialaid/sss, reference school code 1485.
